Dear High Representative/ Vice President Borrell,

We are writing to you regarding the illegal imprisonment of Russian political activist Vladimir Kara-Murza, who has been charged with high treason and faces up to 20 years' imprisonment for his activities opposing Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine and advocating for Russian prisoners of conscience.

There is no doubt that the accusations against Mr Kara-Murza are unfounded. They are aimed at silencing and turning him into an example that deters other critics of Putin's regime and breaks their links with the international community. Among other political hostages of Putin's regime is opposition politician Ilya Yashin.

We take the position that those involved in the illegal imprisonment and prosecution of Mr Kara-Murza should be included on the EU's list of sanctions under the EU Global Human Rights Sanctions Regime (EU Magnitsky Act). There is currently a list of 13 individuals, including police officers, prosecutors and judges, who have been involved in the violation of Mr Kara-Murza's human rights. Please consult the list attached to this letter.

As you are well aware, Mr Kara-Murza is one of the most outspoken supporters of the Global Magnitsky regime of sanctions for grave human rights violations. He has spoken before the European Parliament and the national parliaments of the Member States, as well as in many international forums. He was recently awarded the Vaclav Havel Human Rights Prize by the Council of Europe.

It is high time that we, the European Union, expressed our solidarity with political prisoners of Putin's regime, in particular Mr Kara-Murza. The imposition of sanctions on those involved in his prosecution is the right thing to do, and we hope that you will take the lead.
